Synergy is inviting parties to express their interest in potentially developing solar power station projects in Western Australia.

- Synergy is the largest electricity retailer in the South West Interconnected System (SWIS) with over 900,000 customers and sells approximately 12 TWh of electricity per year.
- Synergy seeks expressions of interest from parties seeking to develop WA-based solar projects connected to the SWIS with a minimum capacity of 0.5 MW and a maximum capacity of approximately 50 MW. If a compelling proposal exists, Synergy will consider proposals in excess of 50 MW of capacity.
- It is favourable, but not essential, that a respondent intends to make a funding application to the Solar Flagships Program managed by the Federal Department of Resources, Energy and Tourism.
