Synergy EV Add On Eligibility Criteria

- 1. The Electric Vehicle Add On product (**EV Add On**) is a time of use tariff offered by Synergy which is subject to the eligibility criteria set out below.
- 2. The EV Add On comprises
 - a. a supply charge at the rate of [123.0000] cents per day;
 - b. an electricity charge for metered consumption:
 - i. 8.2000 cents per unit during the Super Off Peak period;
 - ii. 22.5500 cents per unit during the Off Peak periods;
 - iii. 51.2500 cents per unit during the Peak period; and
 - iv. 18.4500 cents per unit during the Overnight period.
- 3. The EV Add On is available to a Synergy customer who meets the following eligibility criteria
 - a. the customer must be a residential customer;
 - b. the customer's residential address must be a dwelling (being a house, flat, home unit or other place of residence) used solely for domestic purposes;
 - the amount of electricity supplied by Synergy to the residential customer's address must be less than 50MW hours per annum;
 - d. an Electric Vehicle must be registered under the customer's name
 (application will not be accepted for electric vehicles listed under a business
 name) and residential address with the Western Australian Department of
 Transport;
 - e. the customer's name and residential address registered to the Electric Vehicle with the Western Australian Department of Transport must match the name and residential address on their Synergy customer account; and
 - f. the installation of a compatible time of use meter or reprogramming of an existing meter is required at the customer's premises.

For the purposes of the eligibility criteria, an **Electric Vehicle** means a plug in vehicle that is propelled either solely by one or more electric battery motors, or by a hybrid arrangement of an internal combustion engine and one or more electric battery motors.

- 4. New customers who would like to apply for the EV Add On must lodge an electronic application via the Synergy website. The electronic application requires the new customer to:
 - a. provide consent to pay any metering charges associated with the installation of a compatible time of use meter or reprogramming of an existing meter;
 and
 - b. is supported by a declaration that:
 - i. the customer's dwelling is used solely for domestic purposes; and

- ii. the amount of electricity supplied to the customer's premises will be less than 50MW hours per annum; and
- c. is accompanied by a copy of the customer's Electric Vehicle registration which clearly demonstrates that the customer meets the relevant eligibility criteria.
- 5. Existing customers who are currently on the EV Home Plan will have the option to opt into the EV Add On as follows:
 - a. Synergy will send an email notification to existing customers on the EV Home Plan, asking whether the customer would like to opt into the EV Add On;
 - b. To opt in, existing customers can simply respond to the email by clicking the link, filling out the online form and accept the terms and conditions by marking the tick box.
 - c. has opted in, Synergy will transfer the customer from the EV Home Plan to the EV Add On.
