

Synergy EV Home Plan Eligibility Criteria

1. The EV Home Plan is a standard price available to residential customers at a customer's premises which consist of a dwelling (being a house, flat, home unit or other place of residence used solely for residential purposes).
2. The EV Home Plan comprises-
 - a. a supply charge at the rate of **[103.3263]** cents per day;
 - b. an electricity usage charge for metered consumption:
 - i. during the 5 hour period between the hours of 11.00pm and 4.00am each day (**EV Off Peak Period**):
 1. 0.0000 cents per unit for the first 10 units of metered consumption per month; and
 2. thereafter, 20.1131 cents per unit; and
 - ii. during any period other than EV Off Peak Period, 28.8229 cents per unit; and
 - c. a \$200 EV Home Plan Incentive credited to the customer's account in the first year the customer is supplied electricity on the EV Home Plan (**EV Home Plan Incentive**). The EV Home Plan Incentive is exclusive of GST and will:
 - i. be credited to the customer's account in six bi-monthly instalments commencing with the first invoice issued to the customer on the EV Home Plan;
 - ii. only be payable to the customer during the period the customer is supplied on, and eligible for, the EV Home Plan; and
 - iii. where the customer is supplied electricity on the EV Home Plan, or is eligible for the EV Home Plan, for a period less than 12 months, the amount of the EV Home Plan Incentive payable to the customer will be the portion that the number of days the customer was supplied or was eligible for the EV Home Plan bears to 365 (or 366 in a leap year).
3. The EV Home Plan is available to a customer subject to the following eligibility conditions –
 - a. the customer is a residential customer;

- b. the customer's premises consist of a dwelling (being a house, flat, home unit or other place of residence) used solely for residential purposes;
- c. the customer satisfies Synergy that the amount of electricity supplied to the customer's premises will be less than 50MW hours per annum;
- d. an Electric Vehicle is registered at the customer's premises with the Western Australian Department of Transport; and
- e. a compatible time of use meter is installed at the customer's premises.

For the purposes of this clause, an **Electric Vehicle** means a plug in or plug in hybrid electric vehicle.

- 4. A customer seeking supply under the EV Home Plan must make an electronic application via [insert link] to Synergy:
 - a. that consents to pay any metering charges associated with the installation of the compatible time of use meter; and
 - b. is supported by a declaration that:
 - i. the customer's dwelling is used solely for residential purposes; and
 - ii. the amount of electricity supplied to the customer's premises will be less than 50MW hours per annum; and
 - c. is accompanied by evidence which clearly demonstrates that the customer meets the other eligibility criteria.
